Bury Integrated Care Partnership - response to Healthwatch Bury's Prescriptions Report

Response received 8th October 2024

Summary

Executive Summary

Healthwatch conducted a project to explore patient experiences with prescription processes in Bury between December 2023 and May 2024. The project aimed to identify key issues and good practices, resulting in several recommendations.

Key Findings

- Patient Satisfaction: Most respondents were very satisfied or satisfied with their initial contact with healthcare professionals.
- Confidence in Pharmacists: A high level of confidence in pharmacists was noted, with the majority feeling comfortable asking for further information.
- Challenges with Repeat Prescriptions: Many patients found the repeat prescription process difficult and expressed a need for more support, particularly through the NHS App.

Recommendations

Implementation of Findings: The Primary Care Commissioning Committee (PCCC) is advised to receive the report, consider the findings, and support the implementation of recommendations.

North Neighbourhood Prescribing Project: This project aims to improve communication and relationships between general practices and community pharmacies, reduce duplication, and enhance patient-led ordering (PLO).

Strategic Objectives

The report aligns with strategic objectives to deliver improved outcomes through transformation and secure financial sustainability.

Further Discussion Points

Community Pharmacy Services: Despite pressures, community pharmacies continue to provide essential services, including the NHS Pharmacy First advanced service.

Digital Platforms: Encouraging the use of the NHS App for managing prescriptions is a key focus, with efforts to educate patients and staff.

Medicines Supply Chain: Addressing challenges in the medicines supply chain and improving communication between practices and pharmacies is crucial.

Actions Required

The Primary Care Commissioning Committee is required to:

- > Receive the Healthwatch Prescriptions Project report.
- > Consider the collective response to the findings and recommendations.
- Support the Bury-wide implementation of the North neighbourhood prescribing project.
