## Walk-in or pre-book appointments as follows

#### First and second dose Covid-19 vaccinations

- First dose for people aged 16+.
- Second dose for 16 and 17 year olds 12+ weeks after the first; and age 18+ (including within 3 months of turning 18) 8+ weeks after the first.
- Specific clinics for children aged 12 to 15 as noted above, first dose and then second dose 12+ weeks after the first. Alternative clinics can be found via the <u>National Booking Service</u> or call 119.

#### **Booster vaccinations**

• For people aged 16+ at 3+ months (91 days) after the second dose.

### Flu vaccinations

• For all eligible patients.
